On desktop

1. If the organizers need you to upload session info, you will receive a set up link similar to this: <https://whova.com/xems/engage/speaker/xxx/yyy/>
2. Open the link, fill in or update your information such as your bio and photo if needed. If there is anything not editable but you want to edit, please contact your organizers at kennykang@tl.ntu.edu.tw who can enable them for you.
3. If the organizers require you to upload a pre-recorded video or poster, click **Add Video/Document** in the relevant session, and choose the video/pdf source to upload. Whova supports most video formats such as mp4, mov, etc.
